Produce a PowerPoint or Keynote on either gold mining in California during the mid to late 1800s or the importance of steamboats to towns, trade, and entertainment on the Mississippi. Be sure to narrow your topic; you can't cover everything.

- No slides with just pictures; all slides must have information accurately cited
- 3 sources, all ending in .org or .edu or from the library MAS database
- Accurate works cited on a separate slide
- All pictures MUST have a caption explaining the picture and its importance
- PowerPoint compressed and emailed or placed on zip drive

- Content (30 pts): information contained on slides is accurate and relevant to the assignment; captions explain the significance of the illustration in relation to the assignment
- Works cited (30 pts): correctly formatted; contains all required information for each source
- Internal citation (30 pts): correct format is used; all factual information is cited
