For the short story “An Occurrence at Owl Creek Bridge,” find at least one example of each of the following literary devices. Be sure to give a **quote** from the text for evidence for each and **cite** correctly, giving a **works cited** at the end.

1. *Imagery*-the way writer uses words to describe a place or an event. These words "paint a picture" in the reader's mind. They can also appeal to your five senses: sight, hearing, touch, taste, and smell.
2. *Foreshadowing*-the clues that a writer gives the reader that prepares the reader for the things to come later in the story.
3. *Setting*-the time and place in which the events of a story occur.
4. *Conflict*-the struggle between opposing forces in a story.
5. *Internal Conflict*-conflict that exists in the mind of a character.
6. *External Conflict*-conflict that exists when a character deals with an outside force, such as another person, nature, society, or fate.
