Due Date: no later than February 29 (no late work)

Select one of the following women to research (or choose another woman whose exploits interest you – not Loreta Velazquez). You will discover AS A MINIMUM the information contained on the handout: Soldiers, Spies, and Strategists.

Using Keynote or PowerPoint, create a quality presentation that you would show to introduce your female soldier to your classmates. Be sure to include the information required in the handout. You may add more information if you choose. Upload through Edmodo or email. If you email, make sure you COMPRESS the document first so that you do not fill my inbox.

You may select to present your PowerPoint and earn up to 10 points extra credit. See Mrs. Duckworth for dates and sign up. Presentations must be completed before February 29 to earn credit.

Minimum requirements for slides:

- items should be bulleted only (no paragraphs)
- no graphics and other distracting elements (other than theme elements on slides)
- at least one photo which enhances the presentation, with a CAPTION indicating the significance to the subject
- title slide: informative with appropriate heading information
- works cited slide with accurate entries (at least 2)
- minimum of 4 information slides (you will have 6 slides total)
